What's New For 2008:

Version 4.10.0 (available June 2008)

- Access to all updates from June 2008 through May 2009 (i.e., versions 4.10.1 - 4.10.xx)
- Live XML activation through July 2009
- New style format season reports
- New style format career/historical reports
- Play analysis breakdown by "who is on court"
- Improve directory prompts for: import/export, pack/unpack, copy html to disk, backup/restore
- Add menu item for tascii backup/restore in Windows Utilities
- Capability to insert graphic images into the header area of hardcopy "style" reports
- Roster report added to "Season Reports" (features include sort by uni # or name, 'style' format and XML format)

Versions 4.9.1 - 4.9.28 (updates made from June 2007 - May 2008)

- HTML generate: Accommodate Vista to display HTML | View HTML functions.
- Utilities: Modify method for import roster to accommodate Vista (fix to avoid failure in copy of ".bro" file)
- Season reports: Include scoring avg, margin, by period in team statistics section of Combined Statistics report
- Career reports: Filter out values of '0' for individual year-by-year leaders report for years when data not available
- Play analysis: Initial "beta" version of analysis statistics. To use this function:
- Play analysis: Add "court combination" breakouts to the Plus/Minus report
- Live HTML: Optionally display game info within sponsor text (with a line in the sponsor text file containing the tag: <info/>)
- Season reports: Include F-Throws made per game in Team Statistics report and Combined Statistics (team stats section)
- Various fixes and other minor enhancements

2005 (Version 4.7)

- Access to all updates from June 2005 through May 2006 (i.e., versions 4.7.1 - 4.7.xx)
- Live XML activation through July 2006
- Option to include substitutions on the play-by-play
- New report! Player Substitutions
- Career reports: game results are now included in the Season | Summary report and Summary HTML outputs
- Career reports: new "All-time results" report shows game results for each season
- Career reports: new "All-time vs team" report shows game results against a selected opponent
- Career reports: career capture automatically extracts game results; edit function to enter results for prior seasons
- Easier setup for transmit of report files to Sports Systems
- Add page for opponent individual game highs in Season reports | Superlatives | Player game highs
- Add filters to Season reports | Settings | Include games to select:
 - Stats for 1st half only
 - Stats for 2nd half only
 - Stats for final minutes of game
 - Starters-only statistics
 - Bench player-only statistics
- Improve layout of HTML statistics home page
- Include latest version of NCAA team code list (to support Edit RPI codes function)
- Improve layout of the HTML Season Statistics page contents

- HTML pages: Add option HTML | Setup to control whether to use the "new" table format HTML output, or the previous "pre-formatted" HTML output
- HTML table-style: Use Game reports | Live | HTML tailoring value defined in Home stats header | Background for column headers in HTML generation
- HTML pages: Add 'table' style option for career statistics
- Season reports: Treat the visiting team as the "home" team when the Game Setup | Home/Away/Neutral field is set to "A" – indicating an away game for the team in the "home" slot
- Game Viewer: show time of possession stats on the Team Stats screen

- Add Season reports | Stats | Conduct fouls report for NCAA conduct fouls study
- Add Tournament | Generate tournament Html (and View tournament Html) functions to Season Reports
- Game Viewer: Improve resizing method used for enlarge/shrink window (+/-) functions; in particular for the play-by-play view
- Game Viewer: Add "!" (exclamation point) keyboard command to game viewer to switch between display/no-display of top panel (scoreboard) and bottom panel (command buttons) – this is designed to obtain as much usable space as possible for the Stats Summary view for VGA output, especially for output to a video switch or to a TV converter box
