## What's New For 2008:

### **Version 1.10.0 (available June 2008)**

- Access to all updates from June 2008 through May 2009 (i.e., versions 1.10.1 - 1.10.xx)
- Live XML activation through July 2009
- New style format season reports
- New style format career/historical reports
- Table-style format career HTML output
- Automatically prompt *dc* or *gb* after faceoff
- Improve directory prompts for: *import/export*, *pack/unpack*, *copy html to disk*, *backup/restore*
- Capability to insert graphic images into the header area of hardcopy "style" reports
- Roster report added to "Season Reports" (features include sort by *uni #* or *name*, 'style' format and XML format)

### **Versions 1.9.1 - 1.9.10 (updates made from June 2007 - May 2008)**

- Manual entry: fix to avoid setting games played to "1" when editing a season-to-date "game" file
- HTML generate: accommodate Vista to display HTML | View HTML functions
- Utilities: modify method for import roster to accommodate Vista (fix to avoid failure in copy of ".cro" file)
- Manual entry: automatically sort the Goal history list in chronological order after edit
- Roster size: increase roster size from 50 to 75 players
- Live HTML: Optionally display game info within sponsor text -- (add a line in the sponsor text file with the tag: `<info/>`)
- Various fixes and other minor enhancements

## What's New 2003-2007:

### **2007 (Version 1.9.0)**

- Access to all updates from June 2007 through May 2008 (i.e., versions 1.9.1 - 1.9.xx)
- Live XML activation through July 2008
- New style game reports
- Game Viewer - allow for "http" access to game, season, and career XML files via the internet
- Use player uniform number in season HTML files/links for individual game-by-game outputs to allow for more predictable file names (for example, to create links from player bio pages)
- Remember separate rules for each directory (to simplify switching between mens and womens formats)
- Add a separate field in Rules setup to specify the number of overtime minutes for the second and ensuing overtime periods
- Add saves by period to goalie stats in "table-style" Html if that option is enabled; this update includes other cosmetic changes to the "table-style" Html output for the game box score
- Option to mark stats for a player from another team/school (to exclude from season & career leaders)
- Install updated NCAA team code list (`ncaacode.rpi`)
- Game Viewer - implement method to automatically resize viewer window at startup
- Various fixes and other minor enhancements

### **2006 (Version 1.8)**

- Access to all updates from June 2006 through May 2007 (i.e., versions 1.8.1 - 1.8.xx)
- Live XML activation through July 2007
- New "stylesheet" format for live HTML stats with TAS Live
- Career summary all-time, single-season rankings
- Career all-time records vs opponents
- Roster name format functions (*upper,mixed,first,last*)
- Import games list sort by date
- Career category ordinal rankings (1., 2., etc.)
- Prompt team name spelling on roster import
- Option to "hide" opponent season totals
- Add faceoff information to Combined Statistics report
- Career categories for save pct, games played, games started, minutes played
- Various fixes and other minor enhancements

## 2005 (Version 1.7)

- Access to all updates from June 2005 through May 2006 (i.e., versions 1.7.1 - 1.7.xx)
- Live XML activation through July 2006
- Career reports: game results are now included in the Season | Summary report and Summary HTML outputs
- Career reports: new "All-time results" report shows game results for each season
- Career reports: new "All-time vs team" report shows game results against a selected opponent
- Career reports: career capture automatically extracts game results; edit function to enter results for prior seasons
- Easier setup for transmit of report files to Sports Systems
- Game reports: use full team name instead of team ID in short box score report
- Game reports: show line for "TM" in box score if any stats allocated to uniform number "TM" (for example, caused turnovers)
- Add running home-visitor score to the scoring summary in the box score
- Prompt for rules settings when starting in-game or manual scoring (to verify correct mens/womens rules are in effect)
- Deliver a default value of "180" seconds instead of "90" seconds for the Game setup | Rules | Penalties | Match field
- In-game: allow for multiple EMO/PP opportunities to be associated with a penalty by using a result code of "2", "3" ... or "9" – in addition to the standard result code of "Y" to indicate a single EMO/PP opportunity is present
- Tweak the statistics area for in-game scoring to show various team totals in the summary area depending on selected options (for example, show penalties, show facesoffs, show draw controls, etc.)
- Only allow for one assist in-game scoring and manual game entry (unless in NLL or MLL 2-point mode)
- Game reports: add indication in play-by-play of "failed" clear attempt
- Game reports: add option whether to display goalie saves by period in box score
- Game reports: show starters in order entered on Game starters window instead of uniform number order
- Improve layout of HTML statistics home page
- Game HTML: use table format for game box scores
- Season HTML: added Settings | Report options | Use table format option
- Season reports: add free position made-attempts line to the Team Stats report
- Season reports: add draw controls to individual game highs report
- Season reports: add Cumes | Capture season stats for season-to-date reporting to conference office (optional); this function creates files in a "SEASON" subdirectory
- Include latest version of NCAA team code list (to support Edit RPI codes function)
- Implement season-to-date capability for team reporting
- Enable the Settings | Report options | Season-to-date mode option for collecting season-to-date files from member teams, rather than game-by-game reporting
- For season-to-date reporting, teams must use the Season reports | Cumes | Capture season stats which creates files in a "SEASON" subdirectory

## 2004 (Version 1.6)

- *All maintenance updates from June 2004 through May 2005*
- *Live XML activation through July 2005*
- *New conduct reports*
- *New Control Panel feature to access software downloads online*
- Season reports - Add <All players> option for generating Individual game-by-game
- Career stats - Improve format for Edit season | Summary report
- Career stats - Add function to generate season summary HTML file for a historical season (Edit season | HTML summary)
- Extend XML activation for 'Copy to file' function to support Game Viewers
- Add tab stops feature for Season Reports
- Change message prompt for penalty input to include a note showing that "2" is a valid result code (indicating a penalty caused 2 power play opportunities)
- Add functions to track red/yellow card stats (womens venue)
- Add Season reports | Special | Conduct fouls report for NCAA conduct fouls study
- Game Viewer: Improve the resizing method used for enlarge/shrink window (+/-) functions; in particular for the play-by-play view

## 2003 (Version 1.5)

- Add breakouts for conference-only career statistics
- Add breakouts for career statistics vs specific opponents
- Add individual game-by-game statistics to html output
- Add LC Game Viewer feature
