Legacy Version 1.22 (July 2020):

- NextGen fix to national ranking in Season reports
- NextGen Improved spacing in manual entry columns

Legacy Version 1.21 (2019):

Legacy Version 1.20 (2018):

- Add shot clock violation handling in boxscore, team stats, manual entry, and XML for men's rule change
- Fix to calculation of Career Points (goals + assists)

Version 1.19 (2017):

- Season Reports: Use value in Html | Setup | Html-Tags on teamstat.htm page to allow for <html lang="">
- Career Reports: Use value in Html | Setup | Html-Tags on histstat.htm page to allow for <html lang="">
- Updated NCAA team code list

Version 1.18 (2016):

- Game Scoring: Change input menu to "Cl-warn" and "Cl-viol" (instead of "30-warn" and "30-viol")
- Game Reports: Change "30-second clock violation" to "shot clock violation"
- Season Reports: Fix to extraneous 'c' character in Overall/Conf tab stops

Version 1.17 (2015):

- New — Button added to Control Panel to run Conference Career reports
- Conference Reports: Add Career reports feature and applicable reports suite
- Fix to duplicate sog="" attribute in <shots> tag of Career XML

Version 1.16 (2014)

- Add class "=" attribute to <player> tag of XML output
- Season Reports: Resolve truncation of 54-player roster in Individual statistics
- Add shot percentage, SOG percentage, caused T/O, faceoffs won for Team and Player Game Highs

- Include schedule legend in results capture for archives
- Include schedule notes for Next Gen archives

- Career HTML: Add links to seasons within All-Time Results

Version 1.15 (2013):

- Add Penalty codes: TARG, FLAG, CVIO and WITH
- Adjust spacing for boxscore with 45+ players in game to avoid truncation at bottom
- Treat game with Schedule Note = "V" as vacated game — game statistics count, but no win or loss credited
- Season HTML: Add links to individual game-by-game page for individual statistics page
- Season Reports: Individual statistics change column header from "w-l" to "faceoff"
- Add all-time ranking indicator for single-game records to Individual Career History report (only displayed in ranking is within range of Records report settings | # entries for Game records value)
- Move access to the "Delete game records for ..." function on the Edit game records windows (use Delete "All for ..." checkbox)
- Include player single-game highs in "Delete game records for ..." function

Version 1.14 (2012):

- For Display | All selected, show Combined statistics at top of report (if selected)
- Add link index at top of Individual career summaries (all years) section
- Use player names for Individual career summaries internal page markers (to simplify links from bio pages)
- Fix to Individual career summary to show prior school stats when no GP yet at new school
- Add support for faceoff violation and 30-second (stall warning) statistics
 1. Faceoff violations: Enter "Y" in the Violation? Field to indicate the whistle call for a violation
 2. Faceoff violations: After third violation use the "Penalty" command to select the "FACE" penalty
 3. 30-second warnings: Press "W" to indicate a 30-second shot warning
 4. 30-second violations: Press "V" to indicate a turnover due to 30-second expiration called
 5. Goal scored during 30-second warning: Enter "3" in the Goal Type field when scoring a Shot → Goal
- Read/write new data from v1.14.04 (above) into Manual entry and Utilities
- Credit faceoff W-L on faceoff violation to individuals instead of "TM" players
- Eliminate "Expected MORETEAM" message when reading in "older" game files (without new violations functionality)
- Implement scoreboard output feature (requires TAS Comms v.3.14 for serial port output)

Version 1.13 (2011):

- Remove extraneous lines from HTML | XML (by players) output
- Add "Lookup team codes" function to XML output window for Game Reports

Version 1.12 (2010):

- Add support for entry of career-totals-only statistics (career totals for a player, without season-by-season statistics for that era) To use this:
 1. Select Edit | Add new season
 2. Add a season for the last year of the player(s)
 3. Select Edit | Edit season data
 4. Check the "Contains career totals only" option

5. Click the "Individual stats" button
 6. In the "Full roster" list click <New player>
 7. Enter the career totals for a player who last played in that year
 8. Repeat for other players as necessary
 9. Stats entered will be marked as "Contains career totals only" and considered for individual career records, not individual season records
- Fix to tab-stop output for career individual single-game highs
 - Add option to force page break for each player — Individual game-by-game (hardcopy 'style' mode)
 - Improve NCAA team code lookup function
 - Add team total ground balls, caused turnovers to short boxscore
 - Adjust column layout for individual game-by-game report to avoid truncation on right ('style' mode)
 - Conference reports: Fix to Individual Highs report (caused turnovers category), and Individual Leaders report to accommodate number of entries for GB, CT and DC categories
 - Conference reports: Fix to HTML Individual game-by-game pages

Version 1.11 (2009):

- New — Career Single-game Highs report
- Career reports: Add All-time Results and All-time vs. Opponents included in HTML
- Career reports: Show season summary HTML in browser
- Add national rankings in Career results
- Add option for "All years" in Career Summaries HTML
- Add "Minutes" to Edit season data (offensive stats), show minutes played in Individual Career Summaries
- Career reports: Improve filter for "Team" player
- Improve name sort for three-part names (i.e.: "Kevin D. Cox" and "T.J. Rogers")
- Allow maximum six characters for team code in Game Reports | XML output parameters
- Add "Show list of NCAA team codes" to Game Reports | XML output parameters — to display list of NCAA codes
- Career/Historical reports: Accommodate display for results when W-L-T is known, but final score is unknown
- Add "TeamID.CAPH output to Cumes | Capture season stats function to support in-game season-to-date goals input
- Add Settings | Report options | GWG option to control display of GWG in reports
- Add Settings | Report options | Individual stats on 1-page option for printed boxscore ('style' mode) — Boxscore prints on three pages, rather than four
- Add "All players" option to Special | Individual Game Highs report selection
- In Game XML, add "shutout" and "sf" (shots faced) attributes to <goalie> tag, and "stadium" attribute to <venue> tag
- Add "foul" attribute to <penalty> tag
- Career reports: Enforce minutes played for goalies in statistics leaders report
- Suppress shots/shots on goal data columns if these statistics were not tracked in Career reports
- Career reports: Save separate titles for men's, women's venues
- Career reports: Add option to show games started
