- Add class "=" attribute to <player> XML tag

Version 3.15 (2013)

- Game Reports: Add option to display subs in play-by-play report
- Game Reports: Add quick buttons on menu bar for 1st through 5th set-only box scores
- Game Reports: Replace quick button for Short box with quick button for Box summary By Sets
- Treat game with Schedule Note = "V" as vacated game — game statistics count, but no win or loss credited
- Career Reports: Include player single-game highs in "Delete game records for ..." function
- Career Reports: Move access to the "Delete game records for ..." function on the Edit game records windows (use the Delete "All for ..." checkbox)
- Season HTML: Add links to individual match-by-match page from individual stats page
- Career Reports: Add all-time ranking indicator for single-game records to Individual Career History report (only displayed if ranking is within range of Records report settings | # entries for Game records value)

Version 3.14 (2012)

- For Display | All selected, show Combined stats at top of report (if selected)
- Add link index at top of Individual career summaries (all years) section
- Use player names for Individual career summaries internal page markers (to simplify links from bio pages)
- Fix to Individual career summary to show prior school stats when no GP yet at new school

Version 3.13 (2011)

- Fix to heading line in Individual Career Summary when “Show points” is disabled
- Add Support for entry of career-totals-only statistics (career totals for a player, without season-by-season stats for that era). To use this:
 1. Select Edit | Add new season
 2. Add a season for the last year of the player(s)
 3. Select Edit | Edit season data
 4. Check the “Contains career totals only” option
 5. Click the “Individual stats” button
 6. In the “Full roster” list click <New player>
 7. Enter the career totals for a player who last played in that year
 8. Repeat for other players as necessary
 9. Stats entered will be marked as “Contains career totals only”, will be considered for individual career records, not individual season records.
- Fix to tab-stop output for career individual single-game highs
- Fix to player being marked as “prior school” when entered in the scoring software as position “LS” (left-side hitter)
- Add option to force page break for each player -- Individual game-by-game (hardcopy ‘style’ mode)
- Improve NCAA team code lookup function, and update NCAA team codes, for Xml reporting
- Conference reports, add support for “Match consists of sets” option for column headings in Team and Individual Leaders reports (plain text and tab-stops format) and add fix to page breaking for Triple-Doubles report.

Version 3.12 (2010)

- In Career reports, show season summary Html in browser, add national rankings in results, add option for “All years” in Html
- Improve name sort for 3-part names like “Kevin D. Cox” and “T.J. Rogers”
- In Season reports, add ‘*’ to indicate match start in Individual Game-by-Game report
- Add new reports: Special | Double-Doubles and Special | Match-by-match summaries | Assist Match-by-Match
- Add Tournament Reports in Windows: Select Tour | Tournament Team Leaders | Individual Leaders | vs. Opponents Leaders
- Allow maximum 6-characters for team code in Game Reports | Xml output parameters
- Add “Show list of NCAA team codes” to Game Reports | Xml output parameters -- to display list of NCAA team codes
- Season reports: Increase width of “Date” column in results section of Combined Stats report in ‘style’ mode

- Add tag to game Xml, to display a list of players that are currently on the court

- Accommodate display in career/historical reports for results when W-L-T is known, but final score is unknown; in own-score/opp-score fields enter “99-0” for a win, “0-99” for a loss, and “99-99” for a tie

- Career stats - add option to Edit season | Individual stats | From prior team/school to mark statistics for a player from another team or school (these statistics are excluded from the Career leaders and Season leaders reports)
