- Game HTML: Add "Overtime" selection to HTML | Setup
- XML: Add "start=", "end=", and "duration=" to the <venue> tag to contain game start, end and duration times

Version 4.13 (2011)

- Add support for entry of career-totals-only statistics (career totals for a player, without season-by-season stats). To use this:
 1. Select Edit|Add new season
 2. Add a season for the last year of the player(s)
 3. Select Edit|Edit season data
 4. Check the “Contains career totals only” option
 5. Click the “Individual stats” button
 6. In the “Full roster” list click <New player>
 7. Enter the career totals for a player who last played in that year
 8. Repeat for other players as necessary
 9. Stats entered will be marked as “Contains career totals only” and considered for individual career records, not individual season records
- Correct display of “Other Metrics” report when ‘style’ mode is disabled, correct typo of “EFG” on report
- Honor the Records report settings|# entries for Career stats to allow for expanding the Individual year-by-year leaders
- Fix to tab-stop output for career individual single-game highs
- Add option to force page break for each player – Individual
- Add fg pct, ft pct and 3fg pct to game XML for team totals
- Improve font handling for headings in Individual Game-by-Game ‘style’ hardcopy report

Version 4.7 (2005)

- Add option to include substitutions in the play-by-play report
- New report! Player Substitutions
- Career reports: Game results included in Season | Summary report and Summary HTML output
- Career reports: New “All-time results” report shows game results for each season
- Career reports: New “All-time vs team” report shows game results against a selected opponent
- Career reports: Career capture automatically extracts game results; edit function to enter results for prior seasons
- Easier setup for transmit of report files to Sports Systems
- Add page for opponent individual game highs in Season reports | Superlatives | Player game highs
